Point System for Teaching Competency

- Successful attainment of the teaching component for a PhD student means that a student must accumulate a minimum of 10 teaching component points over the course of their degree
- No more than two thirds of the points may be accumulated in one particular area (i.e., students are encouraged to accumulate points from a broad range of teaching opportunities)
