The Lancer Centre triple-court gymnasium will be the new practice and competition home for our Lancer men and women varsity basketball and volleyball teams, and the new home of University of Windsor Convocation, where degrees are bestowed, and thousands of students participate in graduation ceremonies. The triple-gym will host championships, celebrations, Lancer intramural sport and recreation activities, and special events. Seating for 2,000, a suspended 3-lane recreational jogging track, and modern multi-media amenities enhance and expand the visitor experience.

For a donation of \$1,000 (charitable tax receipt will be issued) you will choose your seat, receive a 5” x 1” plaque, that will include your name and year of graduation or other personalized message (limit of 55 characters). The plaque will be located on the base of the seat, in perpetuity. Gifts of \$5,000 or more will be recognized on the Lancer Centre Donor Wall.
