2 UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS

- An emphasis on rigorous scholarship centred on our institutional themes of Access to Justice and Transnational Law.
- An innovative experiential learning component that allows students in the LLM with Certificate in University Teaching and Learning stream to complete a certificate in university teaching, and to engage in law teaching during the course of their study.

2 STREAMS OF STUDY

Students may choose from two streams: a one-year (12-month) regular LLM or a two-year (24-month) LLM with Certificate in University Teaching and Learning.

The central requirement for both streams is the completion of original publishable research.

This major written piece of original research, or thesis, may be submitted as a single document or as a set of related publishable papers addressing a single research question and totalling approximately 100-125 pages.

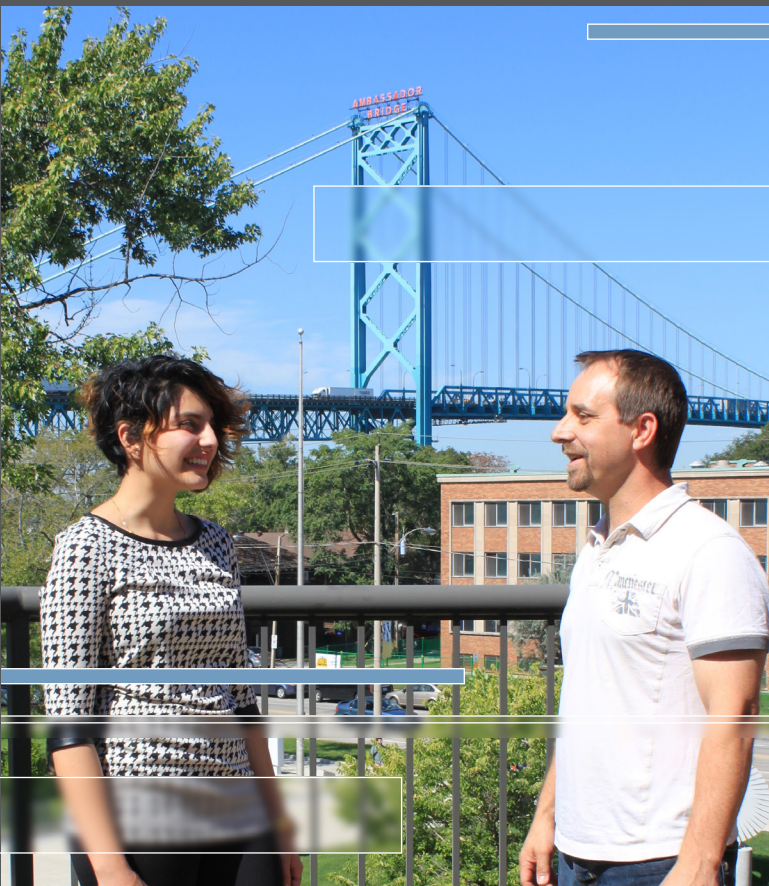

Students enrolled in this innovative program have a unique experiential learning experience.

YEAR 1

Students will complete the University of Windsor's University Teaching Certificate.

YEAR 2

Students will be designated as Teaching Fellows and have the opportunity to complete a teaching practicum at the Faculty of Law.

Formalized university teacher training and law teaching experiences are unprecedented experiential learning opportunities among Canadian LLM programs.

THE PROGRAM

LLM students take courses that enable them to develop a strong research foundation and deepen their knowledge in a given legal or socio-legal field.

Courses include Research Methods, a Graduate Seminar and Legal Theory.

Students enrolled in the LLM with Certificate in University Teaching and Learning stream complete courses in law teaching, lecturing, course design and pedagogical assessment.
