

Application Instructions for Master's Programs in Nursing

The following are the required application materials that must be submitted as part of your online application for the following programs.

- Master of Science in Nursing (MScN) thesis-based and course-based
- Master of Science in Nursing, Primary Health Care Nurse Practitioner (MScN-PHCNP)
- Nurse Practitioner Graduate Diploma

Note: All documents including references must be submitted by **February 1st.** Please complete the application by **early January** to ensure all documents are received by the deadline.

- 1. <u>One completed on-line</u> application. Details can be found at <u>www.uwindsor.ca/graduate</u>.
- 2. <u>Three confidential reports</u> to be completed by academic/professional referees, with at least one from an academic who has taught the applicant and one from a recent employment supervisor. **Important:** Apply a **minimum** of three weeks prior to the application deadline to ensure your referees complete the form by the application deadline.
- 3. <u>Official transcripts</u> of all undergraduate and graduate work from all colleges or universities attended.

Current or past University of Windsor students can print their transcripts through their UWinsite student account (<u>http://www.uwindsor.ca/registrar/uwinsite-student</u>). Official transcripts are not required for University of Windsor graduates.

- <u>Certification of English Proficiency</u> (official IELTS or CELBAN) if you are an applicant from abroad and your native language is not English. IELTS—minimum score: 7.0 or Canadian English Language Benchmark Assessment for Nurses (CELBAN): Minimum scores: Writing - 7; Speaking - 8; Listening - 10; Reading – 8.
- <u>CNO Registration (For Registered Nurses ONLY)</u>. Applicants must have current registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario with no practice restrictions. Please submit a copy of your registration status via Find a Nurse from the CNO website - <u>www.cno.org</u>. The date that you printed a copy should be on the document.

Current Fourth year BScN students – Provide a document stating the program completion date and when you will be writing the NCLEX. Proof of CNO registration is required prior to the start of the program.

MScN – Course-based Stream Applicants

Explain your motivation and readiness for entrance into the MN program. In three pages or less (with double-spaced 12-point font), please comment on:

- 1. Your reasons for seeking a Masters of Nursing (MN) degree
- 2. Professional qualifications, clinical nursing and leadership experiences that you will bring to the program.
- 3. Why you are choosing graduate nursing education at the University of Windsor.
- 4. Your long-term career goals and how the MN degree will contribute to meeting your career goals.
- 5. How selected personal attributes (e.g. communication skills, creativity, organization) that you possess will contribute to your success in a graduate nursing program.

MScN – Thesis Stream Applicants

Explain your motivation and readiness for entrance into the MScN program. In four pages or less (with double-spaced 12-point font), please comment on:

- 1. Your reasons for seeking a Masters of Science in Nursing (MScN) degree
- 2. Professional qualifications, clinical nursing and leadership experiences that you will bring to the program.
- 3. Why you are choosing graduate nursing education at the University of Windsor.
- 4. Your long-term career goals and how the MScN degree will contribute to meeting your career goals.
- 5. A potential research issue upon which you would like to focus your research activities during your course of study.
- 6. How selected personal attributes (e.g. communication skills, creativity, organization) that you possess will contribute to your success in a graduate nursing program
- 8. Individuals applying to the <u>MScN-PHCNP stream or NP GRAD DIPLOMA</u> must also complete the **Verification of Employment Hours Form** and the **NP Personal Essay Questions**.

Applicants must have completed the equivalent of two years of direct nursing (RN) experience in the last five years (>3,640 hours) by the February 1stapplication deadline.
