

Nurse Practitioner - Windsor Family Health Organization

Position Overview:

As an integral member of the Windsor Family Health Organization (WFHO), the Nurse Practitioner will deliver primary care to patients and participate in the development, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of programs and services for patients and families of the WFHO. The Nurse Practitioner will work in collaboration with the Family Physicians of the WFHO.

Duties & Responsibilities:

Reporting to the Lead Physician, the Nurse Practitioner will:

- Provide care to patients in accordance with standards set by governing body and Windsor Family Health Organization guidelines.
- Conduct medical histories, physical examinations, investigations and treatment of patients presenting to the WFHO clinic for medical care.
- Conduct period examinations and risk assessments that may include home visits, pap tests, breast examinations, prenatal care, well baby care and immunizations.
- Scope of care will include adults, children and infants.
- Maintain accurate, concise and confidential EMR documentation pertaining to patient history and physical examinations.
- Communicate ideas and concerns to the team and participate in problem solving.
- Complete in a timely manner administrative data and reporting activity statistics.
- Assist with overflow and special requests from physicians in the group as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.
- Ability to work flexible hours in order to meet patient needs and health team coverage, which may include evenings and Saturdays.

- Current registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario as a Nurse

Practitioner - Primary Health Care

- 1 - 2 years work experience in a primary care setting preferred
- Excellent health assessment/clinical skills
- Strong leadership and interpersonal skills
