In accordance with Section 54-07 of the 2021-2027 Collective Agreement, the Faculty of Nursing invites applications from qualified individuals to teach the following course(s):

COURSE	NURS-8870 Integrative Practicum in Primary Health Care, 4 sections
TERM	Summer (Late June - August)
OUTLINE	Synthesize competencies essential to advanced practice nursing to provide primary health care for clients across the life span. Demonstrate autonomy in decision-making, and critical analysis of organizational and system issues that influence scope of practice, professional accountability, and outcomes. (3 hours seminar per week; 32 hours clinical per week.)
QUALIFICATIONS	Successful applicants must have appropriate academic credentials and teaching competence, as set forth in Article 54:06(a) of the Collective Agreement. Also, must be a Registered Nurse Practitioner with current registration with the College of Nurses and possess a Master's degree or higher with a nursing major or related field. Must be available to teach for the entire term, with no conflicting personal or work commitments

Qualifications: Successful applicants will have appropriate academic credentials and teaching competence, as set forth in Article 54:06(a) of the Collective Agreement, a BScN degree, and be eligible for registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario and a Registered Nurse Practitioner in good standing with no restrictions.

Must be available to teach for the entire term, with no conflicting personal or work commitments.

CLINICAL POSTINGS: Please review any agency restrictions prior to accepting a clinical contract. A completed Synergy Clearance is required that covers the time of the placement.
