

The Armouries



1 Armouries on University Avenue East.

Location:

The Armouries is located at 37 University Ave. E. between Freedom Way and Ouellette Ave. The Armouries houses the School of Creative Arts and the Visual Arts and the Built Environment (VABE) program.

Main Entrance:

The main entrance facing University Ave. E. is accessible, equipped with a ramp and actuators on the front doors. This is a secured building and will require card access. SOCA staff and students will be provided access to their cards/fobs. (Picture is shown above.)

Alternative Entrance

The entrance on the east side of the building facing Freedom Way is also accessible with ground-level access and actuators. This is a secured building and will require card access. SOCA staff and students will be provided access to their cards/fobs.

Bike Racks

Bike racks are in the University of Windsor parking lot east of the AWCCA. Additional bike racks are in front of the Armouries and along Ouellette Street.

Elevator

There is an elevator behind the lobby on the left-hand side (east side of the building). Card access may be required to access various levels.

Parking

- There are three accessible parking spots for the University of Windsor use on the east side of the Alan Wildeman Centre which is located across Freedom Way.
- There are two accessible parking spots on Freedom Way which have a 4-hour limit.
- Students may obtain a student parking pass through the University's parking service for 1 Riverside Dr. East parking garage, next to the Keg. This parking garage has many accessibility features.
- Faculty and staff may obtain University parking permits to the parking garage located at Pitt Street and Dougall Ave. This parking garage has accessible parking but access to the payment kiosk is not very accessible.
- Additional parking is available on the street (meter parking) or other municipal parking garages or lots.

Note: Holders of downtown permits will also be able to use the parking lot at Askin and University Avenues while visiting main campus. For more information, visit the [University of Windsor's parking services website](#).
