

## Chrysler Hall North

### Location

North end of Turtle Island Walk (formerly Sunset Ave.), across from the Education Building. Houses classrooms, offices, Cashier's Office, and is connected to Chrysler Hall Tower from the Ground floor and the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

There is a cul-de-sac on Sunset Avenue for pick-up and drop-off purposes.



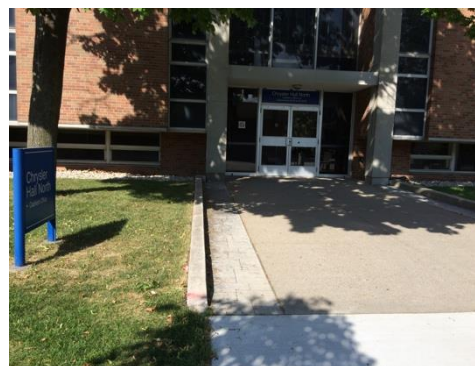
### Accessible Entrance

Accessible entrance is located on the North side of the building. There are actuators and a ramp that lead to the building.

### Alternate Entrances

Standard entrances are located:

- From Turtle Island Walk (formerly Sunset Ave.) across from the Education Building (access to Cashier's office is available here). This is also the south stairwell.
- West Side entrance (opposite to the entrance from Turtle Island Walk (formerly Sunset Ave.); provides access to Cashier's office too—staircase only.
- South entrance, closest to Alistair MacLeod Walk (formerly Patricia Ave.). Stairs only.



### Bike Racks

Bike racks located at:

- West side Entrance
- South Entrance
- Across from entrance on Turtle Island Walk at the Education Building.

### Directory

Directory can be found on right wall at Turtle Island Walk entrance (no braille). Small directories with raised lettering can be found throughout the building.

### Washrooms

Accessible Washrooms:

- Ground Floor only:
  - One Universal washroom, no actuator.

## **Water fountains**

Standard water fountains located throughout the building.

## **Public Telephones**

- Public Telephone found at South entrance, right side of staircase.
- Also found near the at the West side, facing the main entrance/exit.
- There are also two public telephones located near the entrance to Chrysler Hall Tower from Chrysler Hall North. They are low enough for access and have TTY service.

## **Elevator**

Ground:

- Opens South (on North side of the building). On left is hallway towards Chrysler Hall Tower and right is Interdisciplinary Arts & Science and two classrooms.

First Floor:

- Opens South in Political Science area. To go to Cashiers, turn left. To go to Economics and Political Science offices, turn right.

Second floor:

- Opens South and one can either go left or right (east or west).

## **Floors:**

### Ground

- Classrooms, offices
- Accessible Entrance and standard entrances
- Graduate Computer Lab (FASS): has an actuator
- Interdisciplinary Arts & Science offices, and former Interfaculty Offices
- Universal washroom (without actuator)

### First

- Political Science, Economics, History Department offices
- Cashiers Office
  - Call office for hours of operation
- Standard washrooms
- Staircase access (East, North & West)
- Registrar's (access is the South End of the building – this is directly across from the North facing East door of CHT. It is located closest to the Turtle Island Walk (formerly Sunset Ave.)
  - Call office for hours of operation

### Second

- Former Social Work Department Offices (Now located at Downtown Campus)
- History Department
- Philosophy Department
- English
- Research Ethics Board/ Animal Care Committee (signage with braille)
- Lounge area, with removable chairs

## **Parking**

### **Leddy Lot: Staff & Faculty**

- Staff permits are only allowed between 7 am – 4:30 pm Monday to Friday
- There are 6 accessible parking spots with permit only
- Improperly parked vehicles will be towed / ticketed
- Any students or visitors with Accessible Parking permits, requiring the use of this lot, may contact Parking Services to make arrangements.

### **Education: Staff & Faculty**

- Staff permits are only allowed between 7 am – 4:30 pm
- Public parking is allowed Monday to Friday after 4 pm, 4:30 pm
- There are 4 accessible parking spots with permit only, plus an additional 5 spots closer to the Education Building
- Improperly parked vehicles will be towed / ticketed
- Any students or visitors with Accessible Parking permits, requiring the use of this lot, may contact Parking Services to make arrangements.

### **Medical Building (Lot W):**

- Accessible parking: persons are to contact Parking Services ahead of their visit to the University of Windsor
- 5 accessible parking spots with permit only
- 10 Schulich Medicine Faculty parking spots with permit only
- Any students or visitors with Accessible Parking permits, requiring the use of this lot, may contact Parking Services to make arrangements.

There are some additional parking spots along California with parking meters

- (2) Accessible parking spots with permit: (1) west of the Education Building & (1) west of the Toldo Building.
