## **Main Entrance**

The main entrance is located on the north side of the building, directly across from the University Computer Centre. It is **accessible** as it is ground level and is equipped actuators. The elevator in CORe provides access to all four levels in Essex Hall and in the CORe building.

## Elevator

There are two elevators in CORe. The **passenger elevator** is located in the main lobby of CORe. The large **freight elevator** is located through the door to the right of the passenger elevator or can be accessed by taking the passenger elevator to the lower level where both elevators open.

Elevator buttons and door jams are equipped with braille and raised lettering.

Both elevators provide access to Essex and CORe:

- BR Opens at lower level through the rear door
- **G** Main floor (lobby)
- 1R, 2R, 3R Opens east to provide accsess into Essex
- 2, 3 Opens west to provide access to CORe
