## **Toldo Lancer Centre**



Toldo Lancer Centre (TLC)

#### Location

The Toldo Lancer Centre (TLC) is located south of the former St. Denis Centre and the Human Kinetics Buildings. These three buildings are connected and are located off College Ave. between Huron Line and California.

The TLC was designed with accessibility and inclusivity in mind, making it a welcoming space for all. Full details on the accessible and inclusive feature can be found on the <u>TLC website</u>. A synopsis is provided below.

A <u>map outlining the south campus</u> is available on the University's website. This highlights all three buildings, parking and outdoor amenities. The TLC officially opened in 2022. The former St. Denis Centre is now considered part of the TLC complex. The information for this portion of the TLC is located in the section below.

## Main Entrance

The main entrance of the Toldo Lancer Centre (TLC) is accessible with sliding doors and accessible turnstiles at the entry point.

## **Change Areas:**

Change areas are located on the first floor between the pool area and the Fitness Centre.

- Change areas are large and spacious and are both gendered and universal:
  - Each change area features an accessible shower, equipped with seating and hand-held mobile faucets
  - Accessible washrooms in all three change areas (universal- 3, men's-1, women's-1)

• Universal change area is equipped with three adjustable adult change tables to assist with client/user transport

#### Amenities

#### **Dr. Richard Peddie Lancer Commons**

The Commons is located on the first floor next to the main entrance lobby. There is a ramp to the commons with accessible seating in the area. A Starbucks is located in the commons with accessible counters and options to meet diverse dietary needs.

#### Pool

The pool is a fully wheelchair-accessible space. It was designed with accessible entrances and a zero-entry ramp to allow visitors with a disability or mobility limitations greater access. Water wheelchairs for accessible entry are available.

## **Fitness Centre**

The Centre is located on the first floor. This area was designed with open paths of travel and accessible entry points. An elevator is available to provide access to both levels of this area.

#### **Multi-Purpose Rooms**

These rooms are located on the second floor and have ambient lighting to illuminate the entire room and equipment. There are no mirrors to boost inclusivity.

#### **Triple Gymnasium**

Located on the first floor, the gym is equipped with automatic door openers. Bleacher entrances are located on the second level and can be accessed by stairs or elevator. The Concession stand is accessible to guests with disabilities. Wheelchair-accessible seating is available on the court during varsity games.

## **Bike Racks**

There are bike racks along the east side of the HK, St Denis Centre and TLC buildings near the parking lot.

## Elevators

Two elevators offer access to both levels of the facility and are located past the Dr. Richard Peddie Lancer Commons seating area towards the pool. The elevators are equipped with braille and audio signals.

Another elevator is located in the Fitness Centre which brings users between the two floors of this area.

## Parking

There is accessible parking in the east parking lot next to the building. There is also additional accessible parking in the HK Lot which is across from the HK Building on the north side of College Ave. The HK Lot is connected to a crosswalk with signals.

# Toldo Lancer Centre – North Section Formerly the St. Denis Centre



The former St. Denis Centre Athletics and Community Centre is now part of the Toldo Lancer Centre (TLC).

## Location

The former St. Denis Centre is located between the Human Kinetics Building to the north and the Toldo Lancer Centre to the south. It is now considered part of the TLC. These buildings are connected and are located off College Ave. between Huron Line and California.

## Entrance

To access the St. Denis Centre, use the main entrance of the Toldo Lancer Centre (TLC). The main entrance to the TLC is accessible. Upon entry to the TLC lobby, follow the hallway on the right-hand side, past the reception desk.

## Amenities

- Fieldhouse Provides our University of Windsor students and the local community access to an indoor track, basketball & volleyball courts, as well as a mondo surface with badminton courts.
- Indoor Track A state-of-the-art seven-lane, 200m indoor track area.
- The Forge Fitness Centre Provides students an opportunity to pursue a healthier lifestyle with access to all the latest fitness equipment and technology. It is also home to our Lancer Sports Performance Centre and serves as the training grounds for our Windsor Lancers varsity athletes.

## Elevators

A lift is located to the left of the Forge Fitness Centre and accesses the male and female locker rooms and is used to access the Human Kinetics Building. Please note that a key card is required to use this elevator and can be obtained at the front desk. The elevator to the Human Kinetics building is located in the basement of the St Denis Centre. When taking the elevator near the Forge Fitness Centre, this elevator can be found on the left past the seated cushions and vending machines.
