

Vanier Hall

Location

Located at the corner of Wyandotte and Huron Church, between Laurier Hall and MacDonald Hall.

Entrance

The Accessible south entrance from Wyandotte Street (Vanier Circle) is on ground level; there are actuators for two sets of doors.

There is a ramp on the right to gain access to the lower part of Vanier where most of the amenities are located (all one level).



Alternate Entrances

The North Entrance is also accessible (it has a ramp on the right) from ground level to the lower doors. There is a secondary ramp on the left side of the doors when persons can enter the lower level. There are actuators for both sets of doors. There is an emergency exit beside the staircase to go to Café Chez Vanier.



Bike Racks

There are bike racks at the South Entrance on the west side at Cartier Hall (on the right side of the front doors to that building).

There are also bike racks at the North Entrance, and along the sidewalk near the North Entrance.

Directory

The directory is located on the right above the first hallway (from the North Entrance).

Washrooms

Lower Level:

- Women's: barrier free: there is a lowered sink, and a larger stall with a grab bar.
- Men's: barrier free: there is a lowered sink and a larger stall with a grab bar.

These are the only two public washrooms in Vanier hall. They are found down the first hallway on the right, from the North Entrance.

Water fountains

Standard:

- Water fountains are located on the North side of the building, right beside the hallway.
- There is one also available to the right through the doors towards Residence Services.

Accessible:

- Located at the Centre for Language Development (Upper Level).

Public Telephones

- A standard telephone is available on the South end of the building.

- There is a courtesy phone on the North side of the building and on the East side which can be accessed from a seated position.



Elevator

Elevator is accessed through the kitchen. Both public floors can be accessed directly from the outside. It is recommended to take the MacDonald Hall accessible ramp to the open patio area when accessing the second floor.

Floors:

Ground

- Crocodile Grill Overflow
- Crocodile Grill – tables have removable chairs; the doors are open during the operational hours of the Crocodile Grill (during the school year). The aisles are wide and servers will bring food to tables.
 - Breakfast Hours: Mon – Fri 7:45 am – noon ; Sat/Sun 5:00 pm – 11:00 pm
 - Dinner Hours: Mon – Fri 7:00 pm – 11:00 pm ; Fri 5:00 pm – 11:00 pm ; Sat/Sun 5:00 pm – 11:00 pm

- (Note: most rooms and offices will have doors open during the school year).

First (upper level)

- To get to the Centre for English Language Development and Café Chez Vanier, there is a ramp in front of MacDonald Hall Residence which is to the right of the North entrance to the lower level of Vanier Hall.
- This ramp has handrails on either side.
- In the Centre for English Language Development there is a barrier free washroom, and an accessible water fountain between the male and female barrier free washrooms. These are located down the hall from the Secretary's desk.

- Also on the first floor is access to Laurier Hall, where the International Students Centre (ISC) is located.
- Laurier is located to the left of the building, near the Centre for English Language Development. For accessible access to the ISC, there is a yellow callbox outside of the main Laurier Hall entrance, past the ISC entrance, to be buzzed in. Call ext. 3938 for the ISC front desk. The sign and number to call are in Braille on the wall to the left of the door with the call box.

Parking

- There are metred accessible parking spots in front of the south entrance.
- Other parking is available across the Huron Church Road (other side of the Ambassador Bridge) lots A and B are for student parking and C is for Staff/Faculty parking.
- Additional parking is available along Huron Church Road at parking meters
 - (1) accessible parking with permit on the East side of the road.
