

# Faculty Team Leader

**(8–15 positions available)**

## **Role Overview**

Faculty Team Leaders are experienced student leaders who guide and support a full faculty-based Welcome Week team. They act as the primary point of contact between Welcome Week staff and their team of leaders and students.

## **Key Responsibilities**

- Lead and coordinate a faculty-based Welcome Week team
- Support and mentor Faculty Team Coordinators and Faculty Peer Leaders
- Communicate key information to your team clearly and consistently
- Help create a welcoming, inclusive, and positive team culture
- Connect with incoming students ahead of Welcome Week to build excitement
- Assist with organizing and attending Welcome Week and summer social events

## **This Role Is a Good Fit If You:**

- Have previous leadership experience (formal or informal)
- Are comfortable guiding and supporting other leaders
- Can stay organized while balancing multiple responsibilities
- Enjoy mentoring and community-building

Faculty Team Leaders play a critical role in shaping the overall Welcome Week experience for incoming students.

## **Time Commitment & Socials:**

The total time commitment for the Faculty Leader positions ranges from about 20-30 hours total. For Faculty Team Leaders, the role also involves some light engagement throughout the summer (team communication, teambuilding) which is all done online.
