Role Overview

Faculty Peer Leaders are the backbone of Welcome Week. You'll work directly with incoming students, guide them through activities, and help them feel comfortable, included, and supported.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead icebreakers, cheers, and group activities
- Guide students between locations and events
- Engage in conversations and share your student experience
- Support students who may feel nervous or overwhelmed
- Help ensure all students feel welcomed and included

- Enjoy connecting with people one-on-one or in small groups
- Are enthusiastic, reliable, and supportive
- Are willing to initiate conversations and support interactions with others

We invite applications from all students from different faculties, experiences, and leadership styles. Students from any year of study are welcome to apply.

Time Commitment & Socials:
