Information regarding your personal school finances can be viewed through your UWinsite Student account. Students who register will need to check their UWinsite Student account for their balance due. Fees are due within 24 hours of registration if past the due date.

***If you choose not to attend the University of Windsor, you are responsible for formally withdrawing from your courses through UWinsite Student. Failure to attend classes does not constitute a withdrawal and you will still be responsible for paying the fees. Drop dates will be listed on the following website:

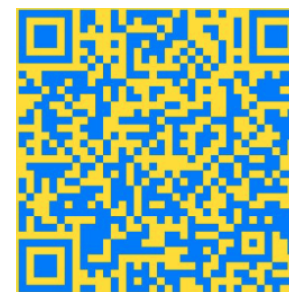
