Year One Requirements

Note: This Checklist pertains only to your Philosophy Requirements. Be sure to coordinate your course selections with your advisor in your second major to ensure timely completion of your degree

Fall Semester

- Introduction to Western Philosophy (PHIL-1000)
- A second 1000-level PHIL course (PHIL-1600 recommended)
- Effective Writing I (GART-1500)

Winter Semester

- Introduction to Ethics (PHIL-2100)
- Effective Writing II (GART-1510)

Year Two Requirements

Standing Required for Continuation and Graduation:

Students must maintain a cumulative average of at least 60% and major average of 60% to graduate.

Courses rotate on a yearly or bi-annual rotation. Be sure to check with your advisor before the Fall term begins to check which courses will be offered. These suggestions cover both Fall and Winter terms of your second year. By the end of your second year you should have taken:

- PHIL 2500 or PHIL 2540
- PHIL 2610
- PHIL 2730 and 2760
- One more PHIL class at the 2000 level:

Year Three Requirements

These courses may be taken in either fall or Winter semesters.

- PHIL 2620 or 3600
- One PHIL course with 5 as middle digit
- PHIL 3760 (recommended)
- PHIL 3700 or 3780
- Any additional PHIL class 2000 level or above

Year Four Requirements

- PHIL 4910 (always offered fall semester)
 - PHIL 4710 or 4720
 - additional PHIL course 3000-level or higher
