NOTICE RE: TEACHING ASSISTANT (TA) POSITIONS AVAILABLE FOR WINTER TERM 2023

In accordance with Article 12:01 of the CUPE 4580 Collective Agreement the Department of Philosophy invites applications for TA positions for Winter term 2023.

The total number of projected Teaching Assistantship positions in the Department of Philosophy for Winter term 2023 is 1 TA position for a total of 100 hours.

All positions are subject to sufficient enrolment and final budgetary approval.

Expected TA duties: The duties in this course will be performed remotely.

It is anticipated that the majority of Winter term 2023 classes across the University will be held face-to-face on campus or have a face-to-face component. TA employees are expected to make themselves available to report for all assigned duties, both on-campus and online. The University of Windsor health and safety protocols and public health and safety regulations that are in place will be observed for any face-to-face or on-campus duties required to support Winter term 2023 courses. Students cannot commence their GA/TA duties until email confirmation of the approval of their contract is received from Human Resources.

Eligibility requirements:

- Applicants must have good communication skills, strong computer skills, and must be able to view/attend courses and exams at the specified time.
- Internet access requirement: must have access to a computer with a reliable internet connection with video and audio capabilities.
- Brightspace experience: must be familiar with Brightspace and MS Teams or be able to acquire knowledge through training.

Successful applicants must be available to report for all assigned duties which may include both in person/on-campus and online duties.

TA appointments shall be offered to qualified applicants in accordance with the criteria specified in Article 12:04 of the Collective Agreement. To be eligible for a Teaching Assistantship you must be a registered student:

- must be registered for the term of work at the time of hiring
- must maintain registration throughout the term and must be in good standing in the degree program

Note that Teaching Assistants can be employed for no more than 100 TA hours per semester total. If you already hold or have applied for another TA position (in this or another department) note that the **total combined hours** for all TA appointments held in all departments **cannot exceed 100 hours for the Winter term period (January 1st to April 30th)**.

Required essential qualifications:

- Students must have completed the course with a grade of at least 80%.
- If no such students apply, consideration will be given to students with grades of at least 80% in philosophy courses that are relevant to the content of this course.

Preferred qualifications:

- Philosophy majors with a GPA of at least 80% in their Philosophy courses.
