



What is Master of Arts (MA) in Political Science?

A Master of Arts (MA) is a graduate degree, done after completing an undergraduate degree (BA).

This degree takes 1-2 years of full-time study through the completion of seminar courses and then either an internship, major research paper or master's thesis.

The skills you will develop in our M.A. program will assist you with your future career plans.

A graduate degree is often required for senior positions in research, policy, and administration.

Graduates from our MA program have an exceptional record following completion of their degrees.

They have gone on to work for Canadian MPs and Senators, in the provincial legislature, and for a number of municipal governments.

Many also work for federal government agencies such as CSIS, Health Canada, and the diplomatic service.

Others have gone on to become lawyers and journalists.

The skills you will develop in our M.A. program will also assist you in securing a place in a Ph.D. program.
