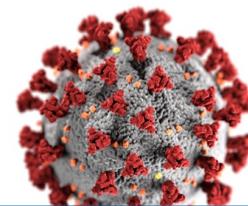

Framework and Process for the Resumption of Research

On June 1, 2020 the University of Windsor implemented [The Resumption of Research Framework](#) to guide a phased approach to resuming research.

Under the Resumption of Research Framework, in-person face-to-face research with human participants is suspended until Research Phase 4. The document, [Research with human participants under COVID19 restrictions](#) outlines the process for researchers who wish to seek an **exception** to this stipulation and **resume, or initiate**, research with human participants that includes in-person, face-to-face data collection with planned, controlled and time-limited breach of physical distancing during Research Phase 2 or Phase 3. 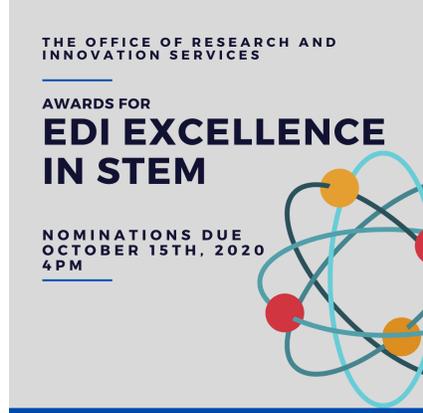

NSERC Discovery Full Application

LOI MUST have been submitted by August 4, 2020 to be eligible to apply

Deadlines (please see email sent by Sara Kenno on August 13 for more details):

 - Science, Engineering, Business – October 2
1. **ORIS Deadline** (with signed ORIS form and complete grant) – October 12 at 4 PM

The Discovery Grants program supports ongoing programs of research with long-term goals rather than a single short-term project or collection of projects. These grants recognize the creativity and innovation that are at the heart of all research advances. Discovery Grants are considered “grants in aid” of research, as they provide long-term operating funds and can facilitate access to funding from other programs but are not meant to support the full costs of a research program.

NSERC Alliance Grants

- Intended for proposals which:
 1. conduct natural science or engineering research that addresses an unmet societal need
 2. connect organizations willing and able to overcome barriers to address these challenges and achieve results that can lead to a societal impact beyond economic benefits [More info](#)

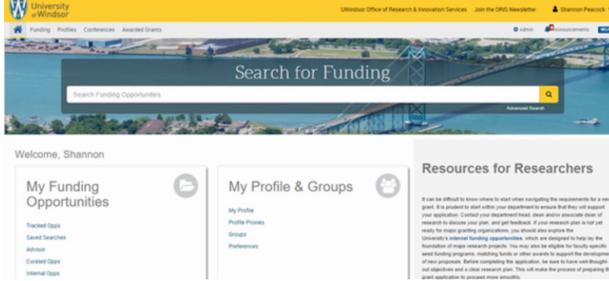
