New Tri-Council Policy Statement for Research Involving Humans

The latest version of the *Tri-Council Policy Statement for Research Involving Humans* has been published TCPS2 (2018). Researchers can find a .pdf of the English version [here](#) and the French version [here](#).

Submitting Grants/Contracts for Institutional Approval

The ORIS deadline is five (5) business days before the agency deadline unless otherwise stated. All applications for external funding must be submitted to ORIS accompanied by an ORIS Information Sheet and Checklist.

Ontario Research Fund – Research Excellence (ORF-RE)

The Ontario Research Fund – Research Excellence (ORF-RE) provides research institutions with funding to support the operational costs of *major projects of strategic value to the province*.

The fund provides up to one third of the total value of a project, with the remaining two thirds coming from a combination of private sector and institutional contributions.

How to Apply

1. notify [Nicole Noël](#) in ORIS that you plan to apply
2. read the [program guidelines](#) and application instructions
3. prepare your application and [ORIS form](#) and submit to ORIS and faculty (see above) by **August 20, 2019** (note: there is no NOI this round)
4. send final version of application to ORIS by **September 18, 2019** for submission by ORIS to the Ministry.



Early Researcher Awards

The [Early Researcher Award](#) (ERA) program helps promising, recently-appointed Ontario researchers build their research teams. Each award is a maximum of \$100,000 and must be matched by an additional \$50,000 from the researcher's institution and/or a partner organization.

The deadlines for this Round (Note: There is *no NOI* this round):

- **September 10, 2019** – Email Nicole Noël and faculty (see above) a draft of the [Application](#) and signed ORIS form.
- **September 17, 2019** - Letters of support forwarded by authors to Nicole Noël at ORIS.
- **October 7, 2019** – Email Nicole Noël the Final Draft for submission to the Ministry by their deadline of October 10.
