Resources for Researchers

It can be difficult to know where to start when navigating the requirements for a new grant. It is prudent to start within your department to ensure that they will support your application. Contact your department head, dean and/or associate dean of research to discuss your plan, and get feedback. If your research plan is not yet ready for major granting organizations, you should also explore the University's internal funding opportunities, which are designed to help lay the foundation of major research projects. You may also be eligible for faculty-specific seed funding programs, matching funds or other awards to support the development of new proposals. Before completing the application, be sure to have well-thought-out objectives and a clear research plan. This will make the process of preparing the grant application to proceed more smoothly.



Creating your Account

Select Use Institutional Credentials:

- Find and Select your institution from the Institution pull-down menu
- Login via our institution's SSO page using your existing institutional login credentials
- Fill in your name and email address when prompted in Pivot-RP and select the "create my account" button to finish configuring your account





Claim your Profile

 Upon logging in for the first time, Pivot-RP may prompt you to claim your profile or to create a profile

- Having a profile (optional) allows you to:
 - get automated funding recommendations based on your research interests, publications, and grants
 - be discovered by potential collaborators



Update your profile



- Select Your Profile from the dropdown under your name, then click edit profile.
- You don't have to manually enter publications and outputs! Enter
 your ORCID, ISNI, and Web of Science IDs to sync existing information
 and make your profile more discoverable. Links to your website, social
 media or other sites are also useful.
- You can also upload files under the Links menu.








- Your proxy must have their own profile in Pivot-RP and must be using a Uwin ID to access.








Finding prospective collaborators




- Click Profiles in the tabs at the top of the page to browse others' profiles:
