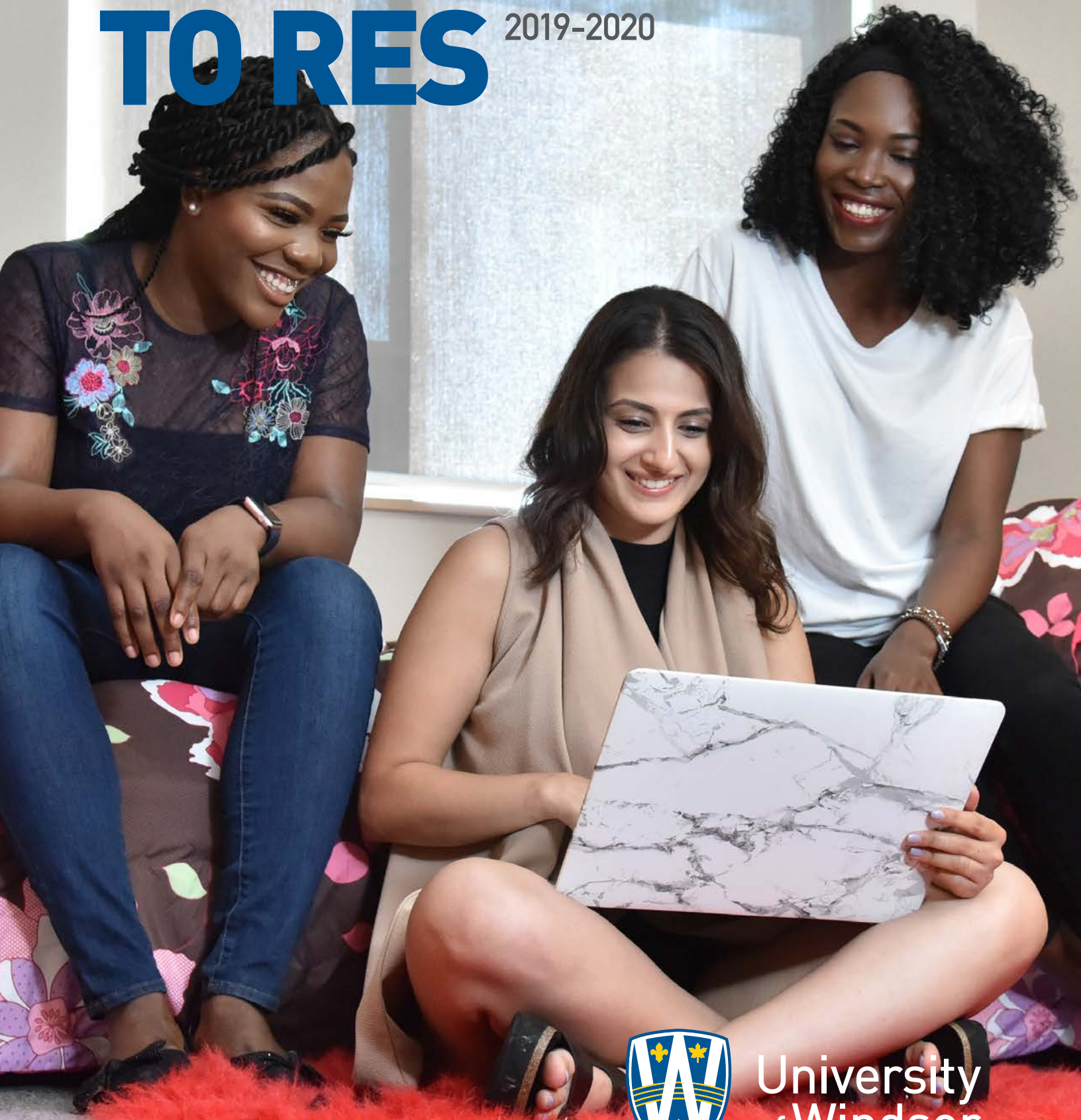

## RESIDENCE LIFE

Residence is so much more than just a place to live. It's a chance to be a part of a community that supports your academic goals and personal development. Living on campus puts you just steps away from your classes, Lancer events, social activities and dining halls.

## SUPPORT AROUND THE CLOCK

Living in residence means you're not alone when you need help. Resident assistants (RA) and resident assistant academics (RA-A) help you transition to university life, make friends, and become a part of the Lancer community. What's more, we have full-time staff who live on campus and are on-call 24/7.

## GET INVOLVED

Our focus in residence is life outside the classroom. You can participate in clubs, become a team leader for residence events, work as desk staff or serve on a residence committee.

## LIVING-LEARNING COMMUNITIES

Live with students who share your academic program. This allows you to connect with your classmates, join them for studying, work on group assignments, or attend social events. Resident assistants and peer mentors design specialized programs that focus on personal and career development in your area of study or interest. Our current offerings include Engineering, Nursing and Science.

## CHOICE OF ROOMMATES

A preferred roommate can be requested. Both students must identify each other on their residence application. If a roommate is not specified, you will be matched based on preferences on your residence application.

## SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS

A limited number of rooms are available to students who require special accommodations. We make every effort to place students in facilities that best meet their requirements.

## RESIDENCE GUARANTEE

Accommodations are guaranteed for first-year students who apply and submit a \$475 deposit by the deadline date. After that date, assignments are based on availability.

Students may apply to residence before accepting their offer of admission to the University of Windsor, however, please see the Residence and Meal Plan Licence Agreement for details on the cancellation/withdrawal policy.

**Note:** An offer of residence does not constitute an offer of acceptance to an academic program.

## MEAL PLANS

All residence students must choose a meal plan from a variety of options, with values ranging from \$4,630 to \$5,352.\* They may use the meal plan to pay for food at outlets on campus as well as several nearby restaurants.

## BOOKSTORE PLAN

For greater convenience, you can add a Bookstore Plan to your Student ID Card.

The plan amount is \$1,000 and is used exclusively at the Campus Bookstore to purchase anything in the store, including all textbooks, both new and used, school supplies and UWindsor clothing for both the fall and winter semesters.

The Bookstore Plan is part of your UWinCARD ID card, just like your Meal Plan. Every time you make a purchase at the Campus Bookstore, the cost of that purchase will be deducted from your Bookstore Plan.

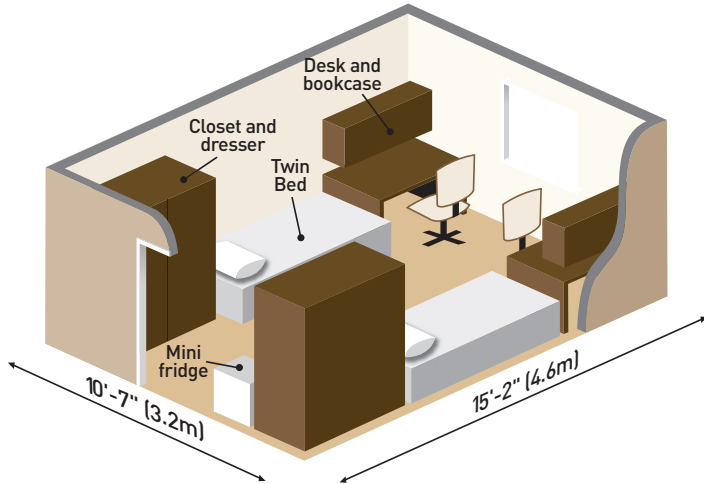
Any bookstore money not spent by the end of the school year can be refunded upon request or will automatically be carried over.

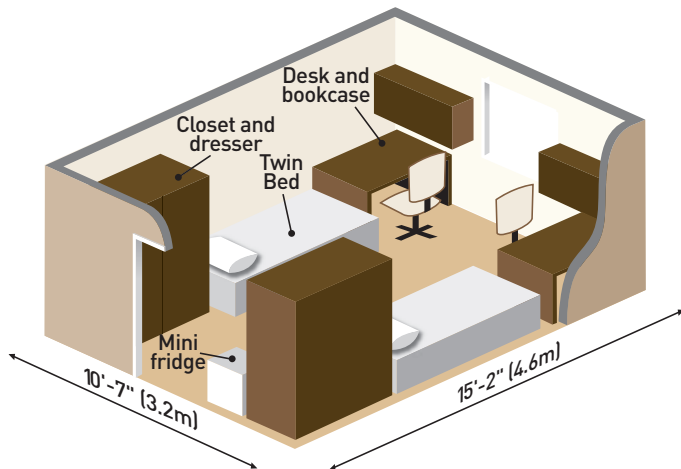


## BUILDING AMENITIES\*



### MACDONALD HALL

- Double rooms and limited single rooms (co-ed floors) with common bathrooms on the floor that are gender specific
- Traditional style building
- Assigned to first-year students coming directly from high school
- Living Learning Communities for Engineering and Science



### LAURIER HALL

- Single rooms with common bathrooms on the floor that are gender specific
- Traditional style building
- Assigned to beyond-first year students

- Bathrooms and Showers
- 24-hour secured building access
- Kitchens or microwave rooms
- Laundry facilities
- Common lounges with cable TV
- Study rooms

- Telephone landline with voicemail, call display and call forward

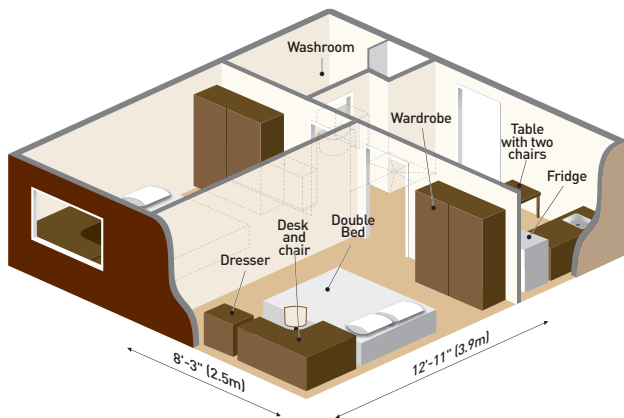
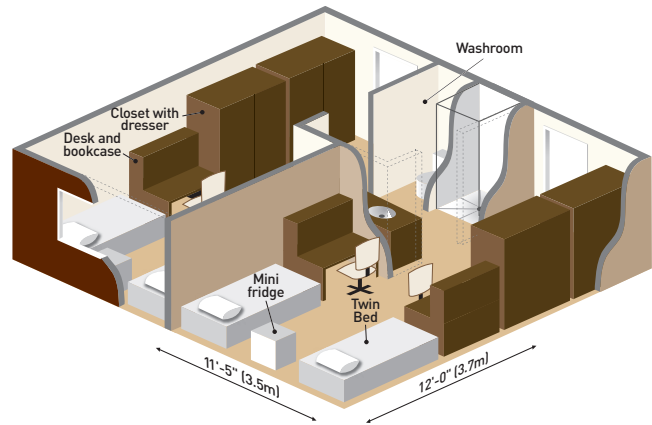
#### YOU BRING:

## CARTIER HALL

- Double rooms – four students share a bathroom
- Close-knit community offers open-concept living
- Assigned to first-year students coming directly from high school



## ALUMNI HALL

- Two-bedroom suites with semi-private bathroom (co-ed floors)
- Assigned to all students. First-year students coming directly from high school are not on the same floor/ wing as beyond-first-year students (with the exception of engineering and nursing communities)
- Grade-point-average requirement for first-year students coming directly from high school
