In accordance with section 54-07 of the 2017-2021 Collective Agreement, the Department invites applications from qualified individuals interested in teaching the following courses:

BIOM 2131-1 Introductory Molecular Biology Lecture and labs (vacant position)	Basic introduction to the molecular biology of the cell with emphasis on basic life processes in both plants and animals, including metabolism, energy transformations, transport mechanisms, signal transduction, and other general functions. The major topics covered include: Regulation of eukaryotic gene expression, fundamental aspects of recombinant DNA technology, DNA cloning, hybridization analysis, microarrays, and protein structure and function. Practical laboratory work will complement the lectures. (Antirequisite: BIOM-2033; Prerequisite: BIOL-1111, BIOL-1101, and BIOL-2111.) (Suggested Corequisite: BIOC-2010.) (3 lecture, 3 laboratory hours or equivalent a week.) In Person

Applications must include:

- ☐ A letter of interest in the position
- ☐ A resume outlining relevant work experience, training, teaching experience, honours or awards, publications, and relevant service activities.
- ☐ (Optional) A teaching portfolio demonstrating evidence of teaching excellence. For example: SET scores or other teaching evaluations, course outlines, graduate courses taken, dissertation or thesis topics, evidence of successful teaching, or/and evidence of professional experience.
- ☐ Three letters of reference for applicants from outside the University of Windsor. *Note: Applicants that have submitted letters of reference for Biomedical Science courses within the last 12 months may choose not to resubmit those letters.*
