

Sessional Appointments – Winter 2027

In accordance with article 54:07 of the 2021-2027 Collective Agreement the Windsor University Faculty Association (WUFA) and the Department of Biology invites applications from qualified individuals interested in teaching the following courses, subject to final budgetary approval, course enrollment and appointment of new full-time faculty.

BIOL 2050 Human Physiology II (vacant position)	WINTER 2027	Introduction to human physiology: a systems approach. Topics include respiratory, endocrine, digestive and renal systems, and control of metabolism. (Prerequisite: BIOL-2040 or consent of instructor.) (3 lecture hours a week.) Mon/Wed @ 8:30am-9:50am In Person
BIOL 3230 Animal Behaviour (vacancy due to sabbatical)	WINTER 2027	This course will emphasize the link between organisms and their environment. The thrust of the course will be to understand why different species behave in different ways and why within species there may be individual differences in behaviour. The aim of the course is to derive a basic understanding of how animals have evolved behaviours that aid in survival and reproduction. Students will gain experience by participating in activities throughout the term. (Prerequisites: BIOL-2101, BIOL-2111, or permission of instructor.) (3 lecture hours a week.) In Person

Applications are to be submitted on or before **September 26, 2026 by 4 PM.**

Applicants who have not previously taught courses in the Department of Biology are asked to submit:

1. a full C.V., that includes relevant prior teaching experience, academic credentials, and publications;
2. a teaching dossier, which includes evidence of teaching effectiveness; and
3. the names and contact details of three people who can provide a reference.
