In accordance with Article 1201 of the CUPE 4580 Collective Agreement, the Department of Mathematics and Statistics invites applications for Graduate Assistantship (GA) and Teaching Assistantship (TA) positions for Inter/Summer Session 2024. There are approximately 11 GA/TA positions in total projected for Summer 2024. All positions are open to GAs and TAs with GA applicants given priority. Each GA position will be for a total of 140 hours. The total number of hours for each TA appointment will depend on the applications received and is anticipated to be in the range of approximately 30-100 hours per position. Each position can be comprised of a combination of any of the below listed courses as needed.

These positions run from May 1st, 2024, until August 31, 2024, unless otherwise noted.

GA and TA appointments are offered in accordance with the criteria specified in Article 12:03 and 12:04 of the CUPE 4580 Collective Agreement. The following are additional essential qualifications for the courses listed above:

- Must have taken the course with a minimum of 80%.
- Must have a GPA of at least 75%.
- Must have an average of at least 75% in all math and stats courses taken.
- Must have strong communication skills.

NOTE: Preference will be given to applicants who have background in mathematics and/or statistics.

Students cannot commence their GA/TA duties until email confirmation of the approval of their contract is received from Human Resources (email titled "Authorization to Commence GA/TA Duties").

GA employees are expected to make themselves available to report for all assigned duties, **both in-person/on-campus and remote/online duties**. Most classes across the University are held face-to-face on campus or have a face-to-face component. Refer to the University's current health and safety regulations.

Undergraduate students must be registered throughout the term they are hired and be in good standing in their degree program to hold a TA position. The total combined hours for all TA appointments held in all departments cannot exceed 100 hours for the entire summer period (May 1st to August 31st). Graduate students must maintain full-time registration throughout the term and must be in good standing in the degree program to hold a GA position. Graduate students who complete their program by the Phase I tuition refund deadline are therefore not eligible. GA appointments cannot exceed 140 hours total for the entire summer period (May 1st to August 31st). Refer to Articles 12, 13, and 14 of the CUPE 4580 Collective Agreement for eligibility details.

Note that graduate assistants must apply each term by the application deadline, in accordance with Article 13: "With respect to those students who have applied for and been accepted for Assistantships, the Assistant will not be paid for any shortfall of hours at the end of their respective program, provided the University has satisfied its obligation to post available positions each term in writing and on the AAU website and to offer the minimum terms of support in accordance with Article 1301 (a) & (b) and provided that the Assistant has applied in writing or via e-mail by the application deadline for each term until they have received the minimum terms of support in accordance with Article 1301 (a) & (b)."
