

## Application for the Tom & Mylo Drake Physics Research Prize

The award will be given annually to a student in Physics of good academic standing who exhibits the best research achievements, based on such considerations as referee reports for published work, prizes or other forms of recognition for conference presentations, and a letter of nomination by the research supervisor indicating the significance of the work, and the portion done by the student.

The nomination package will include a three page summary of the research prepared by the student. This award will be adjudicated by a committee from the Department of Physics to include the Head of Physics. This award is intended as a graduate award but exceptional undergraduate students involved in research are encouraged to apply.
