

Application for the Lucjan Krause Scholarship

The Lucjan Krause Scholarship will award \$1000/year to a student enrolled in any Physics program to recognize their excellence in physics. Students from any year of study may apply but must possess a cumulative average of 75% or greater.

Professor Lucjan Krause headed the Department of Physics through the formative decades of the 1960's and '70s. Dr. Krause came here in 1958 from Memorial University of New Foundland and became the second Head of the Department in 1959. Under his guidance, the Department of Physics quickly developed a reputation as being one of the best Physics Departments in all of Canada.

This scholarship has been established by Professor Krause's family in his name to recognize deserving undergraduate students in any Physics program who through their academic and scientific endeavors bring recognition and honour to the University of Windsor's Department of Physics.
