### 3. Budget Model Discussion

- Undergraduate enrolment growth in both 101 and 105 applications
- Total undergraduate enrolment growth of 175 undergraduate students.
- Expecting course based graduate students will also be up by 175-200 students in growth
- Across campus, enrolment is down. Science should do anything possible to support growth in other Faculties because it will have a net benefit to us.

# 4. Associate Dean, Undergraduate Affairs

#### 11. Other Business

## Discussed Winter 2022 Planning

- Discussed the Provost's message about how the majority of classes in Winter 2022 will be held face-to-face or have a face-to-face component.
- Faculty were told to expect to see significant reductions in distancing requirements. Classes of up to 75 students can be fully face-to-face without distancing requirements. Classes over 75 students will still have a distancing requirement, but this may be reduced (from 2m to 1m).
- Discussed the need to lift capacity limitations on research labs now.
- Council agreed that this isn't enough notice for students so options will still need to be available for those students who can not return to f2f in Winter 2022 (dual online offerings or hy-flex option).
- Registrar's is in the process of scheduling the courses. Some courses may be offered outside the normally scheduled times.
- Faculty were reminded that students who have not completed the vaccine attestation will not be permitted to come to campus. Students are being told to contact their program coordinators or advisors to discuss concerns.
- The vaccine attestation is required for all students, even if they continue to be remote.
- Maclean's magazine ranked the University of Windsor Computer Science program in the top 20 programs within all of Canada. Congratulations Computer Science!
- Biomedical Science's new graduate Translational Science program has been approved by the Provost and is moving to PDC.
