MOTION: That the following revisions be made to the Board of Governors In-Course Medals and the

Calculation of Averages:

Board of Governors In-Course Medals

These medals are awarded annually, in the Fall semester, to the undergraduate student in each Faculty who had the highest cumulative average of all non-graduating students at the end of the preceding regular (September - May) session. A minimum cumulative average of 78.5% is required. The student must have completed the equivalent of at least ten courses at the University and must have been be registered full-time in an honours degree program. Students are considered for this medal based on the Faculty in which they are enrolled at

the time the medals are awarded.

Calculation of Average

Calculation of Averages for Scholarship/Award Purposes

The cumulative average is rounded to the nearest one-hundredth for the purposes of calculating a student's cumulative average.

Rationale:

These proposed revisions formalize current practice and provide greater clarity on the process and eligibility criteria for these awards.
