- Co-operative education programs can provide excellent ways for students to gain practical experience, develop transferable skills, and make valuable connections in their field.
- The degree requirements for the programs will remain the same with the exception of the Political Science programs which will have the addition of one required course POLS-2015 (From University to Work).
- For the Honours Modern Languages and Second Language Education, the co-op option is only available for students in the Spanish stream.
- The proposed extension of co-op to include programs in the arts and social sciences will help leverage enrolment in FAHSS.
- FAHSS was commended for recognizing the importance of Indigenization and making consistent efforts towards decolonization.
