University of Windsor Senate October 7, 2022

AG Value for Money Audit



- The Auditor General of Ontario (AGO) is conducting an audit of "Financial Management & Governance in Ontario Universities"
- Four universities have been selected, and will be covered together in a single report
- Onsite fieldwork took place in June (6 AGO staff on-campus) and follow-up interviews took place throughout the summer
- Report will be issued later this Fall
- A findings follow-up report will be issued in late Fall/24

Cyber Incident Update



- In late June we become aware of a cyber incident and immediately took steps to secure our systems and mitigate the impact to our data and operations.
- A team of leading external cybersecurity experts were engaged.
- Restoration of our systems is complete.
- We have developed a forward thinking cyber risk mitigation strategy which includes:
 - Increased ITS supports
 - Strategic oversight and on-going accountability measures
 - Penetration testing
 - Improved system compliance
 - Training initiatives
 - Movement/migration to 'cloud-based' systems

WECHU Strategic Partnership



- The University and the WECHU announced a strategic partnership in August focused on training, research, student experience and broader community service.
- Involves a WECHU co-location on-campus into Residence Hall West:
 - Jan/24 with a possible 25 yr lease
 - Building will be retrofitted for its services which would include expanded office and clinic space
 - Possible movement of aligned University of Windsor programs into this space as well
- The proposed building retrofit will be reviewed by the Board in the coming months.
- The strategic partnership will also bring together people across both organizations focused on learning, community service and public health to explore areas of training, research, experiential learning, student health services, and increased programming.

Orange Shirt Day



- 12+ events on campus including a community walk, drum social teach-in, and art installation in Leddy Library
- Turtle Island Walk lit with orange lights
- Branded electronic signature, virtual backgrounds, and presentation slide were developed
- T-shirts, lawn signs, and cookbook sales to support Indigenous students on campus
- Healing, support, and educational resources

Special thanks to the Orange Shirt Day Committee, Turtle Island AEC, Office of Student Experience, and Indigenous members of faculty and staff who helped to organize and support these events and initiatives.



Indigenous Space



- AEC is supporting plans to establish additional Indigenous space on-campus.
- Space has been identified at 223 Sunset Avenue – between University and Riverside
 - A property the University purchased in 2021
- Next steps will include retaining an Indigenous architect and developing a renovation plan for the space.




