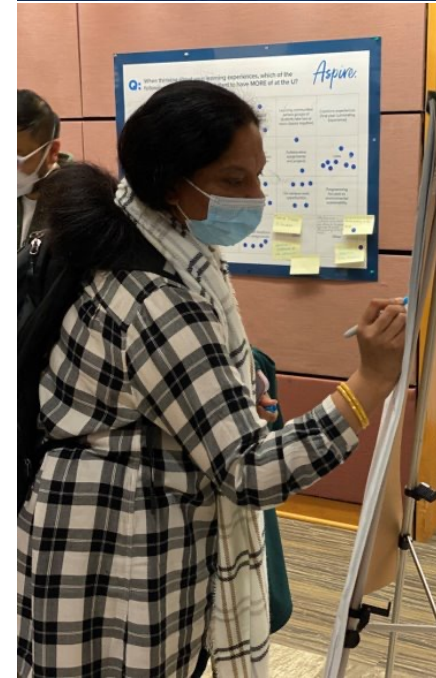

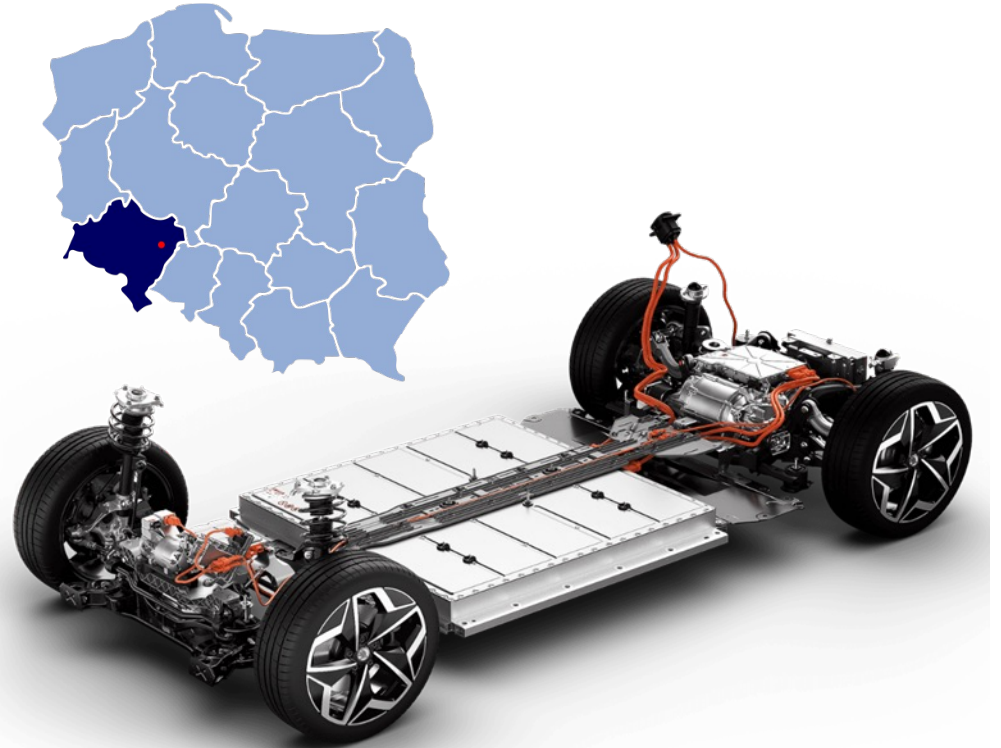
Strategic Planning: Next Steps

- Currently in final draft/design phase
- Consultations engaged more than 5,500 students, staff, faculty, alumni and community members
- Strategic Plan to be endorsed by Senate and Board of Governors in March or April/23
- Foundational Commitments Implementation work begins – April/23
 - Data Strategy and Framework work begins
 - Engagement Strategy work begins
- Cascading plans:
 - SAP and SRP work begins in July/23
 - Indigenization Framework – continuing from ASPIRE
 - Regular updates on planning and timelines for all cascading plans to be provided to Senate and Board



Stellantis/LG Energy Solutions: Poland

- Related to Stellantis/LG Energy Solutions Seed Program
 - Advanced hiring and training program for recent graduates
 - Advanced, on-site training at LGES global facilities
- First visit: will be returning to learn from their successful research ecosystem.



Windsor Essex County Health Unit (WECHU) Partnership

- In summer 2022, a new partnership was announced between the University and WECHU for co-location and joint programming opportunities:
 - Academic program development in area of public health
 - Research collaboration opportunities being explored
 - Strategic consultative collaboration to serve neighbouring communities and support student experience
 - Planned retrofit of Residence Hall West with occupancy planned for 2024
- Partnership meetings and municipal outreach underway
