Treaty Recognition Week

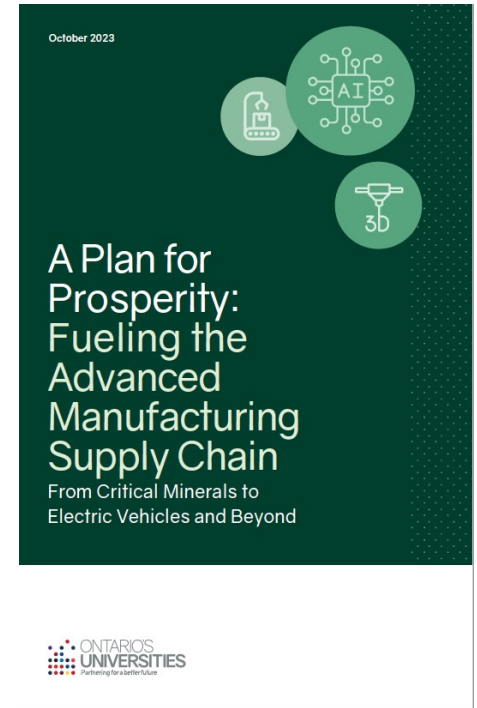
