Iranian Students' Memorial

- Held on Monday, January 8, 2023.
- Honoured members of our campus community who died in the January, 2020 downing of Ukraine International Airlines Flight 752 shortly after its takeoff in Tehran.
- Of its 167 passengers, 138 were enroute to Canada, among them University of Windsor research assistant Samira Bashiri; engineering PhD students Hamidreza Setareh Kokab, Pedram Jadidi, and Zahra Naghibi; and Naghibi's spouse Mohammad Abbaspour Ghadi.

Food Insecurity and Education

- Food insecurity is a major problem among postsecondary education students in Canada.
 - Higher than the in the general population
- Food insecurity is a social justice issue.
 - Impacts the most marginalized among our students (resource-limited; racialized; mature students with families; 2SLGBTQ IA+).
- Food insecurity is a student success issue!
 - Impacts physical and mental health and the ability to be energetic and productive.
- Historically it is students who have borne the burden of addressing food insecurity with little help from their institutions. It is time for us to play a leading role working with students.
- Many students suffer in silence!
 - Social stigma surrounding hunger and food aid.



Addressing Food Insecurity at the University of Windsor

Long Term

 Develop and implement a strategic, evidence-based Food Security Action Plan

Short/Medium Term

- Establish initiatives to provide food NOW eg:
 - ➤ Bring a non-perishable item to every Senate meeting (you can do the same in your faculties and departments)
 - ➤ Bring a non-perishable item to every sporting event
 - ➤ Establish a Food Security Fund (incorporate into the institution's annual giving program)
 - ➤ Support current student efforts
 - Establish external collaborations and partnerships to enhance campus food security


September 2023 – Reorganization to form Campus Safety & Emergency Planning under VPFO
