
# 2020/21 Proposed Tuition and Compulsory Ancillary Fees

## **Tuition Fee Approval Process**



### **Executive Summary: Tuition Fees**

#### **Domestic Student Tuition**

- Domestic rates remain frozen for 2020/21, following 10% reduction and 2year freeze starting in 2019/20
- No announcements from MCU to date on future tuition framework

#### **International Student Tuition**

- Steering Committee proposes rates based on shared principles:
  - Consistency with competitor's rates across Canada
  - Feedback from recruiters, Deans, students and prospective students
  - Comparability of cost per student
    - Domestic Tuition + Government Grant (WGU-based) ≈ International Tuition
  - Affordability for students mid-stream
- In 2020/21, propose different rates for incoming (new) students than continuing students
- Transitioning towards a multi-year, cohort-based tuition fee structure

# International Undergraduate Tuition Fees

### **International Undergraduate Tuition Fees**

### **Enrolment Levels (post COVID-19 assumptions)**

- Budgeted headcount (Fall 2020): 708 students
- Faculty concentration: Science (38%), Engineering (25%), FAHSS (23%),
   Odette (12%)

### **Proposed Strategy**

- Higher rate increase for incoming (Year 1) tuition of 5% to 16%
- Upper year students (Years 2, 3, 4) increase of 5% (maximum)

#### **Rationale**

 UWindsor lagging the median due to aggressive increases implemented by the majority of other Ontario institutions in 2019/20

### **Enrolment Levels (post COVID-19 assumptions)**

- Budgeted headcount (Fall 2020): 361 students
- Faculty concentration: Engineering (48%), Science (31%), FAHSS (11%)

### **Proposed Strategy**

- Modest increase of 1.5% for all research-based graduate programs (all years)
- Odette MBA Programs:
  - MBA to increase by 9.5% in Year 1, and 5.0% for Year 2
  - MBA-Accounting to increase by 7.7% in Year 1, and 5.0% for Year 2

#### Rationale

- Comparison difficult in this category as tuition costs offset in different ways depending on institution GA funds, scholarship funds, research funds.
- Graduate Studies, AVP Enrolment Management provide insight to market.

- Budgeted headcount (Fall 2020): 2,308 students
- Faculty concentration: Engineering (63%), Science (25%), Odette (11%)

### **Proposed Strategy**

- Higher rate increase for incoming tuition of 1.5% to 15.5%
- Continuing students increase of 5% (maximum) for 2020/21

#### Rationale

- Competitor data (where available) and program demand
- Graduate Studies, recruiters, AVP Enrolment Management provide insight
- University remains committed to making financial support (including scholarships and bursaries) available to international students



# **2020/21 Compulsory Ancillary Fees**

## 2020/21 Compulsory Ancillary Fees

- Ancillary Fee Committee approves fees (majority of voting members must be students)
- CPI rate provided by the Canadian Federation of Students (CFS) is 1.9493%
- Changes relate to CPI increase, student organization fee changes, and increased costs
- Cost Recovery Course Fees new course fees and changes to some course fees for increase in cost of supplies and field trip expenses
