Application Deadline: January 15, 2025

The applicant is responsible for collecting *all* required materials and submitting them through the eGAS application <u>website</u>.

An application of admissions consists of the following items (see Information and Instructions for Applicants form for details):

A completed on-line Application to the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research - required by the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research. This includes the application fee. Visit the Graduate Studies Website and follow the instruction to pay the fee.
Transcripts must be submitted for all college, undergraduate and graduate programs you have attended (submit through the eGAS application website). Unofficial transcripts and documents can be uploaded into your application. Hard copies will not be accepted.
All transcripts must satisfy the following requirements: - Name of the Institution it is coming from - Degree awarded (or enrolled in) - The credit weighting & grade awarded for each class - Your name must be on the transcript
** Requirement: Completion of a Social Work degree (undergraduate or graduate) from an accredited university and a graduate degree with a minimum A- average.
Please note: the University of Windsor will not obtain your UWindsor transcript on your behalf; you must upload your Uwindsor transcript in eGAS.
Proof of language proficiency. See language requirements outlined in the School of Social Work's Information and Instructions form.
Three references consisting of two academic references, and one reference from either an academic, helping professional or an employer. Referees will be contacted to submit their reference forms online only after you have uploaded all of your documents to the University of Windsor electronic application system (eGAS) and have submitted the application online to the Registrar's Office. Instructions on how to do this will be emailed to you after you submit your online application and pay the application fee

Please be advised that all references are due by the application deadline.

	A detailed Curriculum Vitae. which includes your post-secondary education, experience in social work (including paid, volunteer, full/part time, international and practicum/internship), research experience, presentations, scholarship awards, professional publications, reports (research or technical), and presentations at scholarly conferences.

	Sole or co-authored sample of professional or academic writing.
