Expected GA duties:

Assistants cannot commence their GA/TA duties until email confirmation of the approval of their contract is received from Human Resources (email titled "Authorization to Commence GA/TA duties").

GA employees are expected to make themselves available to report for all assigned duties, **both in-person/on-campus and remote/online duties**. Most classes across the University are expected to be held face-to-face on campus or have a face-to-face component. Refer to the University's current <u>health and safety regulations</u>.

Eligibility requirements:

Successful applicants must be available to attend at the specified time of the course/lab/exams and to report for all assigned duties, which may include both in-person/on-campus and remote/online duties.

GA appointments will be offered to qualified applicants in accordance with the criteria specified in Article 12:03 of the CUPE4580 Collective Agreement.

To be eligible for a Graduate Assistantship you must be a registered fulltime graduate student:

- must be registered for the term of work at the time of hiring
- must maintain **fulltime** registration throughout the term and must be in good standing in the degree program.

GA appointments cannot exceed **140 hours total for the Summer term period** (May 1 - August 31, 2024). Refer to Articles 12, 13, and 14 of the CUPE 4580 Collective Agreement for eligibility details.

Required essential qualifications:

Successful applicants must meet all essential qualifications.

- Must have access to a computer with a reliable internet connection with video and audio capabilities
- Must be familiar with the universities LMS (Brightspace) and MS Teams or be able to acquire knowledge through training
- Cumulative academic average of 75% or higher
- Availability to attend both virtual classes/labs/exams/office hours and on-campus in-person classes/labs/exams/office hours as required by the course instructor

Preferred qualifications:

- Cumulative academic average of 80% or higher
- Background relevant to advertised courses
- Having taken and successfully completed the course before
