At this time, there has been no decision made by the US Department of Education as to whether or not this waiver will be extended to Winter 2021.
 - **Distance Education Courses for Winter 2021** – The US Department of Education will not permit students to receive US Federal Student Aid in a term where you are registered in distance course(s) (even if only one of your courses is a distance course). The University of Windsor has not yet announced the delivery method of courses for the Winter 2021 term. At the present time, if you study in any distance courses at the University in the Winter 2021 term, you will be required to self-fund. Should the US Department of Education change the distance education policy you will be notified by email.

DISBURSEMENT OF DIRECT LOAN FUNDS
