The recipient must be registered as a part-time undergraduate student in the Department of English Language, Literature, and Creative Writing. If there are no eligible English major candidates, the award will be open to students in the Department of Languages, Literatures and Cultures. The successful applicant must have completed a minimum of five courses on a part-time basis at the University of Windsor and possess a minimum cumulative average of 70%. Previous recipients cannot be considered. The total value of part-time awards received by a student may not exceed \$3,500 per academic year. Apply on-line.

The recipient must be in at least Year 2 of studies and completed a minimum of ten courses as a part-time student at the University of Windsor. This award was established in 2002 by the Organization of Part-Time University Students (OPUS) in recognition of Dr. Kathleen McCrone's dedicated

service to the promotion of academic excellence and to the University of Windsor, where she served as the Dean of the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences for 12 years.
