CHARTERED PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTANT DESIGNATION

If you're interested in a career in accounting, you can complete the educational requirements of the Chartered Professional Accountant (CPA) designation through the Odette School of Business. Whether you are a recent high school graduate or a graduate from another bachelor program, we offer a pathway for you.

Students enrolled into the Bachelor of Commerce program have the option to apply into the Accounting Concentration. By successfully completing the 19 accredited CPA Entry to PEP preparatory courses while earning a Bachelor of Commerce degree, you can apply for the Odette MBA-PAS program or enrol in CPA Ontario's Professional Education Program (PEP).

CO-OP

Co-operative education offers a well-rounded education that incorporates academic theory and real-world application. By combining semesters of study with full-time, paid employment in career-related positions, you will be able to:

- Apply classroom knowledge to the workplace
- Gain hands-on experience related to your academic program

- Explore career options and clarify your career goals
- Learn how to compete confidently in the job market
- Earn a wage to help offset the cost of tuition (all work placements are paid, full-time positions)

The Application Process

Business and Business/Computer Science:

The co-op program begins early in your degree to allow time to experience three four-month work terms. You can apply in two ways: directly from high school or online in the summer before your second year (called a Year 2 application).

The Year 2 application deadline date will be in mid-September. The Year 2 application process is competitive, therefore, the average required for acceptance may be higher than what is required directly out of high school.

The University of Windsor enjoys a broad range of student exchange partnerships with other universities and post-secondary institutions around the world. Students who participate invariably report that it is the single most valuable part of their university experience. Students in any undergraduate program can apply for exchange.

Normally, exchanges last one or two semesters after completion of four or more semesters of study at the University of Windsor. No tuition is charged by the partner institution, as students continue to pay their UWindsor tuition while away. Some financial assistance and awards are available, including an International Travel Bursary (\$750 per semester) and other destination specific awards. All course credits obtained on exchange may be applied to the University of Windsor degree requirements as appropriate.

CLUBS AND TEAMS

More than a dozen Odette student-run teams and clubs are excellent ways to meet and connect with peers, network with people from the community, and benefit from experiential learning opportunities. Our competitive student teams travel across the world and have enjoyed great success.

FINANCIAL MARKETS LAB

The Odette School of Business is home to a state-of-the-art finance lab which includes 12 Bloomberg terminals. All Odette students can obtain their Bloomberg Certification at no additional cost. Our students are encouraged to utilize the lab to gain the resources and tools necessary to become experts in the world of finance.

ODETTE STUDENT SUCCESS CENTRE

The Odette Student Success Centre is a unique environment geared towards personalized support and comprised of a team of highly skilled advisors. FIRST-YEAR SUPPORT

Your university career is one of the most important steps of your life. We want to help you get started on the right foot. Our knowledgeable advisors are available to help you make this transition easier. We want you to succeed. This is accomplished through academic, professional, career and peer support.

H.O.U.S.E MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

The H.O.U.S.E. (Helping Odette Undergraduate Students Excel) Program supports the transition of students into undergraduate studies at the Odette School of Business. The program ensures that incoming students connect with current student leaders who provide guidance, coaching and mentoring. Each student is assigned to a H.O.U.S.E. at the beginning of the year. The program also promotes upper-year student engagement and involvement in extracurricular activities.

TUTORING

We provide free tutoring for business students. The best method to improve your grades—or to maintain consistently strong grades—is to seek help early! This free tutoring support is provided in addition to instructor office hours and course teaching assistant support.

MID-TERM CHECK-IN

First term—and first year—can be challenging for new students. Mid-terms and finals are often an especially stressful time. For this reason, our academic advisors outreach to students with less than a 60% average in all required first-year business courses, informing them about the resources and tools available to help them succeed.
