LEAD VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY Committee Member

DESCRIPTION

A Committee Member will be responsible for the development and improvement of Head Start and Lead by participating in one of three committees:

- Head Start Committee: This committee assists with the development and enhancements of sessions and campus tours offered at Head Start. This committee is overseen by the Student Development Specialist.
- Lead Recruitment Committee: This committee assists with the development and enhancements of Volunteer Selection Board recruitment and training as well Lead Volunteer recruitment initiatives and General Selection Workshop. This committee is overseen by the Lead Student Coordinator.
- Training Committee: This committee assists with the development and enhancements of the training program provided to Lead Volunteers. Examples of training programs developed by this committee include General Training, Head Start Training Conference, Head Start Module training and UWindsor Welcome Week training. This committee is overseen by the Transition Services Intern.

In participating in one of these three committees, Committee Members are responsible for providing ideas and input based on their previous experiences and involvement in Head Start, UWindsor Welcome Week and Lead. Previous experience in a hands on capacity volunteering with Head Start, is required to apply for this position. There is a time commitment of 4 hrs/week associated with this position. The role is active from September to April

QUALIFICATIONS

This position is best suited for an individual who is optimistic and can relate well with others. The volunteer must be able to problem solve and be comfortable interacting with a variety of people. The volunteer must also demonstrate mentorship qualities. The volunteer must be in good academic standing.
