DESCRIPTION

A Volunteer Selection Board Member will be responsible for the Lead Volunteer selection for the coming year. Applicants must have experience as an Event Volunteer in order to apply.

Volunteer Selection Board Members are responsible for running workshops and administering recruitment initiatives. There is a time commitment of 4hrs/week associated with this position and the role is active in February & March. This position would provide the incumbent with the opportunity to enhance many skills including teamwork, communication, decision-making, leadership and time management. Note that this position is for involvement in the Lead Recruitment process in 2026, not 2025.

QUALIFICATIONS

This position is best suited for an individual who is optimistic, can relate well with others and is organized. The volunteer must be able to problem solve and promote a positive team dynamic. This role requires that the volunteer have initiative, strong communication skills, good judgement and the ability to meet deadlines. Previous experience in the Standard Stream is required. Availability for the majority of Group Selection Workshops and Volunteer Selection Board training is mandatory. The volunteer must be in good academic standing. In applying to this position, you consent to the Student Success and Leadership Centre confirming your academic standing with the University of Windsor.
